Portsmouth City Council (Dundas Lane) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.82) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **22nd July 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

DUNDAS LANE

From the junction of Quartremain Road to the junction of Burrfields Road.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate modifications to the north and south accesses to Admiral Lord Nelson School, including the extension of the central island in front of the south access and new road markings.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 22nd July 2019 for 6 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, works will take place overnight between 20:00 to 06:00 between 22nd July 2019 and 3rd September 2019.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from Dundas Lane, Airport Service Road, Eastern Road (A2030), Burrfields Road and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
