Portsmouth City Council (Station Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.98) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **30th September 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

STATION STREET

From the junction of Commercial Road to Slindon Street.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate crane lift works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 30th September 2018 for 2 weeks or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the works will be carried out between 0400 and 1600 on Sunday 30/09/2018 or Sunday 07/10/2018.

D) VEHICLE DIVERSION

Eastbound: Slindon Street, Station Street, Arundel Street, Holbrook Road, Bradford Junction RAB, Winston Churchill Avenue, Lord Montgomery Road, Hampshire Terrace, St Michaels Road, Anglesea Road, Alfred Road, Market Way, Hope Street, RAB Market Way, Unicorn Road, Stanhope Road.

Westbound: Stanhope Road, Unicorn Road, Alfred Road, Anglesea Road, St Michaels Road, King Richard 1st Road, Winston Churchill Avenue, Holbrook Road, Arundel Street, Station Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the southern footway. Cyclists dismount and follow pedestrian diversion.
