

Sustainable design and construction supplementary planning document

Adoption statement

1. This statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 11(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. It gives notice that Portsmouth city council formally adopted the Sustainable Design and Construction Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 28th January 2013.
2. There have been modifications to the SPD pursuant to section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Those made as a result of consultation responses are set out in the Consultation Statement. Those made pursuant to Section 23(1)(b) involve correcting a factual error in section 3, changes to sections 2, 3, 4 and appendix 1 of the SPD.
3. A person with sufficient interest in the decision of the city council to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. The application must be made to the High Court in a prompt manner and in any event not later than three months following the date of adoption given in paragraph 1.
4. The SPD, the Consultation Statement, the Sustainability Appraisal and Strategic Environmental Assessment Screening Statement and this Adoption Statement are available on the city council's website at <http://www.portsmouth.gov.uk/living/3850.html>, at the Civic Offices during normal office hours and at the city's libraries.
