

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (KA OLD PORTSMOUTH) (RESIDENTS' PARKING ZONE AMENDMENT) (NO.13) ORDER 2016

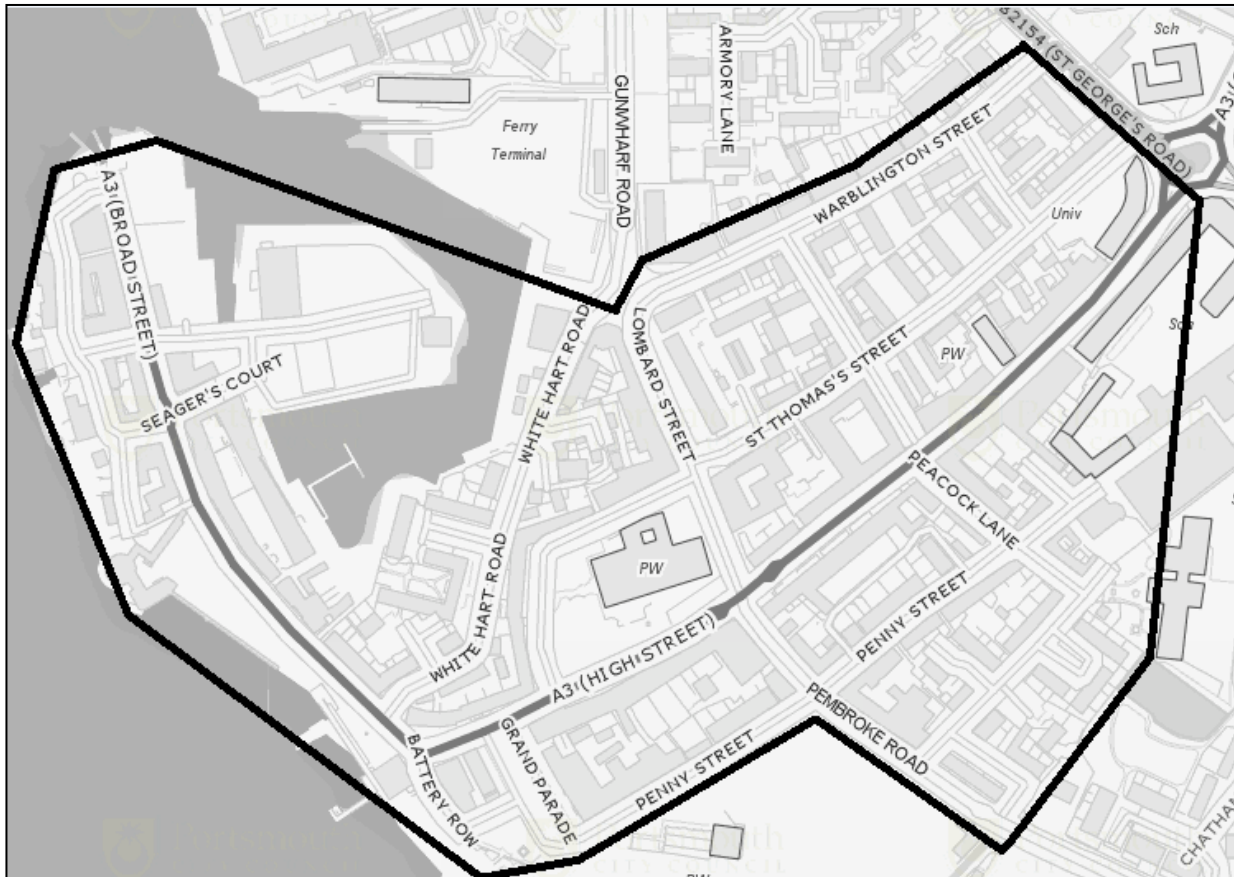
Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 20 April 2017 made the above Order under sections 45 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 4 May 2017 and the effect will be as follows:

A) RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES: CHANGE TO FREE PARKING PERIOD

FROM: 2 HOURS, NO RETURN WITHIN 4 HOURS

TO: 1 HOUR, NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS

KA ZONE BOUNDARY:



A copy of the Order can be made available at the Civic Offices during normal office hours (please email engineers@portsmouthcc.gov.uk to arrange), and a copy of this public notice can be viewed on Portsmouth City Council's website - visit and search 'traffic regulation orders 2016'.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 20 April 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
