Can I apply to vote by proxy?

- You must be fully registered to vote under the system of Individual Electoral Registration in order to qualify to vote by proxy..
- You must ask someone who is willing and able to be your proxy and vote on your behalf. A person can be the proxy for only close relatives (spouse, civil partner, parent, grandparent, sibling, child or grandchild) and up to two other people at the same election.
- The person you have chosen as your proxy must be also be fully registered to vote themselves in order to be able to act on your behalf. Please contact us before applying if you are unsure about whether the person you wish to act as your proxy is eligle to do so.

How do I apply to vote by proxy?

- Ask the person you want to act as your proxy whether they are willing to do so.
- Fill in the application form overleaf. You must give a reason why you want to vote by proxy, for example that you will be abroad on holiday on election day.
- Make sure that you complete all sections of the form and supply your date of birth and signature. If you are unable to sign this form yourself, please contact Election Services.
- Return your completed form promptly to the address below

What happens after I have returned this form?

- Your proxy must go to **your** local polling station to vote. If they cannot get there then they can apply to vote by post as proxy once they have been appointed by you.
- Your proxy will be sent a poll card telling them where and when to vote on your behalf.
- You should let your proxy know how you want them to vote on your behalf: for example, which candidate or which party.
- If it turns out that you are able to go to the polling station on election day then you can vote in person yourself (unless your proxy has already done so or has applied to vote by post on your behalf).

We must receive your completed and signed form by no later than 5pm on the sixth working day before an election in order to set up a new proxy vote in time for that election.
