

Reducing Crime Through Design Supplementary Planning Document

Adoption Statement

This statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 19(b)(ii) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and gives notice that Portsmouth City Council formally adopted this document on 10th March 2006.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the council to adopt the Reducing Crime Through Design Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document.

Any challenge to this decision must be made on the grounds that the document has not been made in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated Regulations have not been complied with.

Any such challenge must be made no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
