

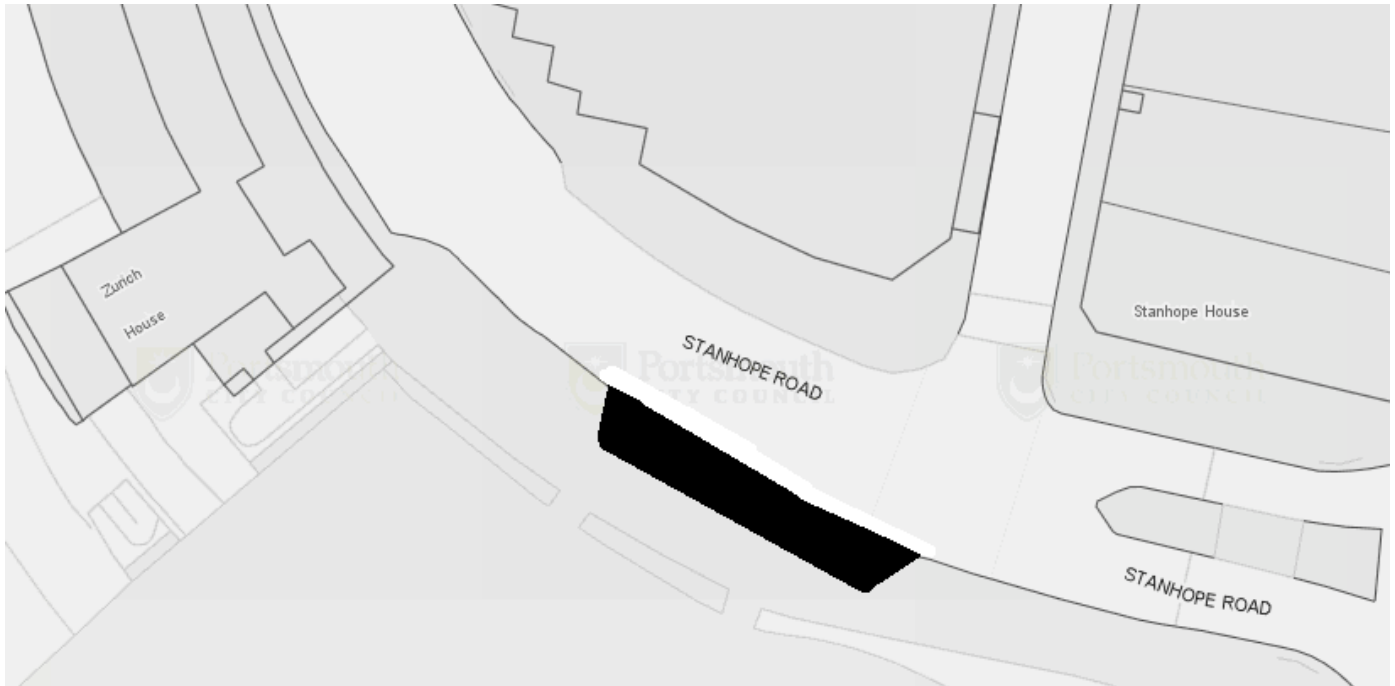
THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (STANHOPE ROAD) (LOADING PROVISION) (NO.17) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 5 October 2017 made the above Order under Sections 1 – 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order comes into operation on 19 October 2017, to effect:

A) CHANGE FROM NO WAITING AND NO LOADING AT ANY TIME (double yellow lines) TO: LOADING ONLY

1. Stanhope Road

South side, within the new 27-metre layby adjacent to Catherine House (former Zurich building)

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 5 October 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
