

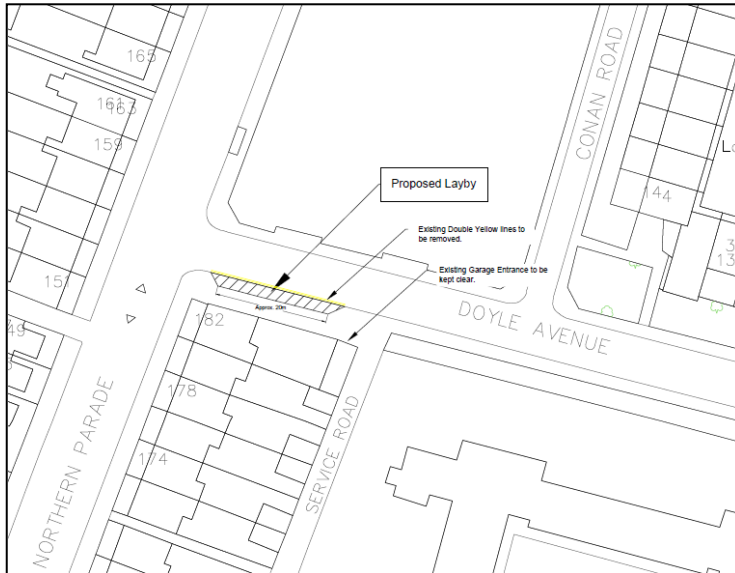
## **THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (DOYLE AVENUE) (AMENDMENTS TO WAITING AND STOPPING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.24) ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 20 June 2017 made the above Order under Sections 1 – 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 4 July 2017 and the effect will be as follows:

### **A) CREATION OF LAY-BY AND REMOVAL OF ADJACENT DOUBLE YELLOW LINES**

#### **1. Doyle Avenue**

South side, a 20-metre length between Northern Parade and the service road



### **B) REMARKING OF SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS (YELLOW ZIG ZAGS)**

#### **1. Doyle Avenue**

South side, current single 75m length to be split into 2 lengths (approximately 27m and 45m); westernmost to be remarked to remain compliant

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 20 June 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
