

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (PRINCE GEORGE STREET) (AMENDMENTS TO PARKING PLACES) (NO.28) ORDER 2017

2 March 2017: Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 32, 36 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be a revised parking layout, increasing parking provision by up to 3 spaces:

A) CHANGE FROM PARALLEL PARKING TO ECHELON PARKING

1. Prince George Street

The west side of the north-south section, the 25-metre length opposite the play area (capacity to increase from approximately 5 spaces to 8)
