The Portsmouth City Council (Portsmouth LGBT Pride) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.36) Order 2016

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Saturday 18th June 2016**.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (ROLLING CLOSURE)

From 13.00 to 14.00, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary for the safe passage of the Portsmouth LGBT Pride parade.

DIVERSION

A rolling road closure will be in place. Traffic will follow the parade and roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so. 'Temporary obstruction for 15 minutes' signs will be placed while the parade crosses King Richard 1 Street.
