

## **THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 38) ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 20 June 2017 made the above Order under Sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 4 July 2017 and the effect will be as follows:

### **A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS\* (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)**

\* Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at these locations.
