

## **THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 42) ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 11 July 2018 made the above Order under sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order comes into operation on 24 July 2018 and the effect will be as follows:

### **A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS\* (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)**
