**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (SPECKS LANE, MILTON LANE, ANSON ROAD)  
(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND AMENDMENTS) (NO.43) ORDER 2016**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1 – 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be to support the traffic management scheme in the vicinity of the Portsmouth Football Club stadium as follows:

**A) CHANGE FROM SINGLE YELLOW LINE AND PART-TIME LOADING BAN TO:  
DOUBLE YELLOW LINES AND PART-TIME LOADING BAN**

**1. Anson Road**

East side, the existing 94-metre length southwards from the junction with Rodney Road

**B) NO WAITING AND NO LOADING ON FOOTBALL MATCH DAYS**

**1. Specks Lane**

(a) West side, a 25m length adjacent to No.44 Carisbrooke Road

(b) East side, a 23m length adjacent to No. 46 Carisbrooke Road (outside No.2 Specks Lane)

**C) CHANGE FROM SINGLE YELLOW LINE TO DOUBLE YELLOW LINES**

**1. Milton Lane**

North side, extend the double yellow lines for 6 metres north-eastwards (to prevent parking across the corner)
