

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (WELLINGTON STREET)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES) (NO. 46) ORDER 2017**

27 April 2017: Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1 – 4, 45 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to effect:

A) NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (double yellow lines)

1. Wellington Street North side, a 19-metre extension to the existing restriction from the eastern dead end in front of the new parking bays

B) CHANGE FROM: NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (double yellow lines)

TO: RESIDENTS' PARKING LA NORTH SOUTHSEA ZONE

WAITING LIMITED TO 3 HOURS, NO RETURN WITHIN 4 HOURS (LA PERMIT HOLDERS EXEMPT)

1. Wellington Street South side, 9 metres outside nos. 42/44 Wellington Street at the eastern end
