

**PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION)
NO.58 ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 29 May 2018 made the above Order under Sections 32, 33, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act.

The effect of this Order, which will come into operation on 11 June 2018 is to update and consolidate into one Order the existing off-street parking Orders. The restrictions remain unchanged. The Orders to be replaced and revoked are as follows:

- The Portsmouth City Council (Seafront Promenade and East Street) (Off-Street Parking Places) (No.35) Order 2015
- The Portsmouth City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) No.9 Order 2017

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 29 May 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
