The Portsmouth City Council (Portsmouth City Fireworks) (Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No. 87) Temporary Order 2016

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding along and parking in the roads and the length of roads set out in the Schedule on Wednesday 2nd November 2016.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND PARKING (EXCEPT BUSES)

From 6.00pm to 7.45pm on Wednesday 2 November 2016, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary:

1. NORTHERN ROAD From its junction with Portsmouth Road and Medina Road roundabout in both directions.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND PARKING (INCLUDING BUSES)

From 7.45pm to 8.30pm on Wednesday 2 November 2016, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary:

1. NORTHERN ROAD From its junction with Portsmouth Road and Medina Road roundabout in both directions.
2. NORTHERN ROAD From its junction with Medina Road roundabout to 40 metres south of its junction with Portsmouth Road in both directions.
3. PORTSMOUTH ROAD 90 metres south of Highbury Way to its junction with Portsbridge Roundabout in both directions.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary to enable the safe movement of pedestrians going to and from the Portsmouth City Firework display at King George V Playing Fields, Cosham.
