

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ISAMBARD BRUNEL ROAD) (REMOVAL OF BUS LANE AND NO WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (NO 87) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 31 August 2017 made the above Order under sections 1-4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended, Parts III and IV of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, and under section 75 of The Highways Act 1980 and of all other enabling powers. The order comes into operation on 14 September 2017, to effect:

A) EXTENSION OF FOOTWAY INTO CARRIAGEWAY (BUS LANE) TO INCREASE PEDESTRIAN AREA

The separate westbound traffic lane (approximately 130 metres) on the west and south sides of Isambard Brunel Road, starting north of Alec Rose Lane and ending west of Dugald Drummond Street

B) DELETION OF BUS/TAXI/CYCLE LANE AND NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

1. Isambard Brunel Road

The approximate 130m length of bus lane on the west and south side of Isambard Brunel Road, starting north of Alec Rose Lane and ending west of Dugald Drummond Street

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 31 August 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
