The Portsmouth City Council (Milton Common and Great Salterns Quay) (Public Right of Way Closure) (No. 15) Temporary Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation on 4 April 2016 and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTWAY

COASTAL PATH BETWEEN MILTON COMMON AND LANGSTONE HARBOUR Starting at the southern end of Milton Common, next to Langstone Campus University Village with the closure ending to the north of Great Salterns Quay – a total of 1.86km.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

The Order is required to facilitate Phase 2 of the North Portsea Island Coastal Scheme.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order will be in operation for up to a maximum of 6 months.

D) DIVERSION

The diversion will make use of the paths that criss-cross the Common, so the temporary path will be set back and run parallel to its current alignment as indicated by signage. Between Milton Common and Great Salterns Quay, the path will be diverted along the shared pedestrian and cycle path of the A2030/Eastern Road.
