**Portsmouth City Council (Southwick Road) (Temporary Speed Reduction) (No.22) Order
2020**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) and 14(4)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **10th February 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY SPEED REDUCTION FROM 60MPH TO 40MPH

Southwick Road

From the national speed limit sign south of Portsdown Hill Road roundabout to the entrance to QinetiC.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate mechanical road sweeping and cleansing.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 10th February 2020 for 11 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the speed reductions will be notified by the placement of on-street signage prior to works taking place on the following dates:

From 2300 on 10th February 2020 to 01:00 on 14th February 2020;

From 2300 on 20th April 2020 to 01:00 on 25th April 2020;

From 2300 on 15th June 2020 to 01:00 on 19th June 2020;

From 2300 on 10th August 2020 to 01:00 on 14th August 2020;

From 2300 on 12th October 2020 to 01:00 on 16th October 2020;

From 2300 on 14th December 2020 to 01:00 on 18th December 2020.

D) DIVERSION

Existing speed limit signage will be covered and temporary on-street speed signage placed on-street.
