The Portsmouth City Council (St Mary's Palm Sunday Procession) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.29) Order 2018

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Sunday 25th March 2018**.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (ROLLING CLOSURE)

From 09.25 to 10.00, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

1. FYNING STREET

In its entirety.

2. HOLBROOK ROAD

At the pedestrian crossing from Fyning Street to Common Street.

3. COMMON STREET

From its junction with Holbrook Road to its junction with Lord Street, east along public footpath beside Harley Court.

4. KING ALBERT STREET

From Crown Court to its junction with Church Road.

5. CHURCH ROAD

To its junction with Fratton Road

6. FRATTON ROAD

From Church Street into St. Mary's Church.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary for the safe passage of the St Mary's Palm Sunday Procession.

DIVERSION

A rolling road closure will be in place. Traffic will follow the parade and roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so.
