**The Portsmouth City Council (Tertiary Road Network Resurfacing - Various Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.29) Order 2020**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from 10th March 2020 to 31st August 2020 and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

CHATSWORTH AVENUE	From the junction of Wembley Grove to the junction of Highbury Grove. Diversion: Wembley Grove, Highbury Grove and Highbury Grove, Hawthorn Crescent, Wembley Grove.
FAWCETT ROAD	From Lawrence Road to Albert Road. Diversion: Albert Road to Lawrence Road and vice versa. (Chetwynd Road and Darlington Road will be managed by marshals).
FESTING GROVE	In its entirety. Diversion: Festing Road, Eastern Road, St Georges Road and vice versa.
PENNY STREET	In its entirety. Diversion: Pembroke Road, St Nicholas Street.
HALFPENNY LANE	In its entirety.
FARTHNG LANE	Closed at its junction with Penny Street.
PEACOCK LANE	From its junction with Penny Street to its junction with St Nicholas Street.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

The Order is required to facilitate **resurfacing works** under road closures, lane closures and the use of temporary traffic signals stop and go and give and take systems when needed.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order will be in operation for a period of 10/03/2020 - 31/08/2020 or completion of the works, whichever is sooner, as notified by the placement of signs and letters to affected residents and businesses 14 days prior to each works.

A copy of the Temporary Order may be examined at the Information Desk, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, and Portsmouth during normal office hours.
