**Portsmouth City Council (Mutiny Festival) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting)
(No.35) Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **27th May 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

NORTHERN ROAD (EXCEPT BUSES) From its junction with Portsmouth Road to the roundabout with Wayte Street & Medina Road) for a distance of approximately 655 metres.

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING

PORTSMOUTH ROAD Along A27 running along King George V Playing Field for approx. 420 metres.

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate egress from the Mutiny Festival.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 1800 on 27th May 2017 until 0100 on 29th May 2017.

E) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from A397, Portsmouth road, and onto High Street, and then onto Wayte Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
