**Portsmouth City Council (Incidents on the Highway) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving)
(No.45) Order 2020**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(b) and 15(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **21st April 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

No vehicle shall proceed in any road or length of road in the City of Portsmouth where it is required to be closed in the event of an incident which is likely to cause significant congestion.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

Because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order shall come into force on 21st April 2020 and, in accordance with section 15 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the authority are satisfied that the execution of the works in question will take longer than the time-limits specified in subsection 15 (1); but in any case the authority shall revoke the order as soon as the works are completed.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles will be diverted around the incident as appropriate to minimise congestion on the network.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where appropriate and safe to do so.
