**Portsmouth City Council (Bredenbury Crescent) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.52) Order 2020**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **12<sup>th</sup> May 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING**

BREDENBURY CRESCENT

From the junction of Dorstone Road to the junction of Leominster Road.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate Openreach maintenance works.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 for 18 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, works are expected to take place for 1 day, plus one day contingency in the event of adverse weather, between 09:30 to 15:30. The order will continue to be in force for eighteen months if works are postponed. Rescheduled dates will be notified by the placement of signs and letters to residents and businesses.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Bredenbury Crescent to Ludlow Road to Leominster Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
