**The Portsmouth City Council (James Callaghan Drive) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.91) Order 2016**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **21<sup>st</sup> November 2016** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING**

JAMES CALLAGHAN DRIVE

From Portsdown Hill Roundabout to the Fareham boundary.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

The Order is required to carry out a CCTV survey and cleansing of the highway drainage system.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

The Order will be in operation from 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016 for 18 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, it is expected the closure will be in place for no longer than 5 nights from 23:00 to 05:00 from 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016.

**D) DIVERSION**

A3 - A27 - Downend Road and vice versa.
