The Portsmouth City Council (Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme) (Byway Open to All Traffic) (No. 99) Temporary Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14 (1)(a), Section 15 (1) (a), Section 15 (3) and (5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **1st October 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE TO PEDESTRIANS AND VEHICLES (INCLUDING CYCLISTS)

LONDON ROAD COASTAL PROMENADE LEADING TO TWYFORD AVENUE From the junction of London Road to Twyford Avenue.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

In accordance with Section 15 (9) 3 (c) and (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), this order continues the previous order **The Portsmouth City Council (Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme) (Byway Open to All Traffic) (No. 20) Temporary Order 2017** which came into force for 6 months from 1st April 2017 expiring on 30th September 2017. This order (No. 99) will expire on 31st March 2018, or on completion of the works whichever is the earlier to ensure public safety.

D) DIVERSION

Cyclists and pedestrians will be diverted from Twyford Avenue to London Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian and vehicle access to businesses will be maintained along London Road Access Road to Hilsea Lido.
