Portsmouth City Council (Resurfacing - Various Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.82) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **1st September 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

GOLDSMITH AVENUE	In its entirety. (Night works) Diversion: Priory Crescent, Milton Road and vice versa. Local diversions will be signed.
MILTON ROAD	In its entirety. (Night works) Diversion: Goldsmith Avenue, Fratton Road, Rodney Road, Priory Crescent and vice versa.
TANGIER ROAD	In its entirety. (Night works) Diversion: From its junction with Dover Road to its junction with Folkestone Road. No access to St Pirans Avenue. Diversion: Milton Road, Baffins Road, Hayling Avenue, Whitecliffe Avenue and vice versa.
DOVER ROAD	From its junction with Eastbourne to Tangier Road. (Night works with Tangier Road works) Diversion: Eastbourne Road, Chesterfield Road, Tangier Road.
HAYLING AVENUE	In its entirety. (Day works) Diversion: Eastern Road, Tangier Road, Milton Road or Baffins Road, Langstone Road, Eastern Road.
ST MARY'S ROUNDABOUT	All approaches. (Night works) Diversion: New Road, Kingston Road, Fratton Road, Goldsmith Avenue, Fratton Way, Rodney Road, Velder Avenue, Eastern Road, Burrfields Road.
EASTERN ROAD	From its junction with Walton Road to A27. (Night works) Diversion North: A27/A3, Havant Road. Diversion South: Eastern Road, Havant Road, A27, Harts Farm Road, and A27.
HAVANT ROAD	From its junction with Gillman Road to Rectory Avenue. (Night works) Diversion: Eastern Road, A27, A3, Havant Road, A27/Harts Farm Road, A27.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate resurfacing works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 1st September 2020 for 12 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Each works will be notified by the placement of signs and letters to affected residents and businesses. (Works may include temporary traffic signals, Stop and Go boards and Lane Closures).

Notwithstanding the above, the order will continue to be in force for eighteen months if works are postponed due to reasons connected to coronavirus. Rescheduled dates will be notified by the placement of signs and letters to residents and businesses.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted as described above for each works.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
