**Portsmouth City Council (Castle Road) (Temporary No Through Road and Prohibition of Loading and Waiting) (No.83) Order 2020**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **1<sup>st</sup> September 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY NO THROUGH ROAD AND PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING (EXCEPT NORTHBOUND DELIVERIES BETWEEN 9AM - 12 NOON)**

CASTLE ROAD

31 metres south-east of Hambrook Street,  
and 4 metres north-west of Regent Place.  
(Loading permitted outside No.s 79 - 87  
Castle Road between 9am - 12 noon)

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

For purposes connected to coronavirus.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

The order will continue to be in force for a maximum of eighteen months from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020. Notwithstanding the above, it is anticipated that the closure will be in place until 30 April 2021.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Southsea Terrace, Bellevue Terrace to Hambrook Street.  
Pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained.
