Portsmouth City Council (Clarendon Road - The Strand) (Temporary Prohibition of Loading and Waiting) (No.91) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **12th October 2020** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING

GRANADA ROAD

For 35 meters south-west of The Strand roundabout on the southern side.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate Openreach works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 12th October 2020 for a maximum of 18 months, or completion of works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, works are expected to take place for a maximum of two nights between 21:00 and 06:00. The order will continue to be in force for eighteen months if works are postponed. Rescheduled dates will be notified by the placement of signs and letters to residents and businesses.

D) DIVERSION

No vehicle diversion required.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
