

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (RESIDENTS' PARKING ZONES) (AMENDMENTS TO RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES FOR SECURE CYCLE PARKING) (NO. 37) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2021**

The Portsmouth City Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Residents' Parking Zones) (Amendments to Residents' Parking Places for Secure Cycle Parking) (No.37) Experimental Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the 15 March 2021 for a maximum period of up to 18 months.
2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Section or Part or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Section or Part or Schedule bearing that number or letter in this Order unless otherwise stated.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. The Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby varied as specified in that Schedule.
5. The Director of Regeneration may modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential:-
  - (a) In the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic;
  - (b) In the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities;  
or
  - (c) For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
6. The requirements, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any requirement, prohibition or restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act, or by any other enactment.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ORDERS**

- 1.** The Portsmouth City Council (Residents' Parking Places) (Consolidation) (No.1) Order 2020
  - a)** Amend Items 10 (b) (iii) and (iv) in Schedule 41 relating to a residents' parking place in Manners Road to read:
    - (iii) from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Talbot Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 55 metres
    - (iv) from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Francis Avenue in a westerly direction for a distance of 16 metres
    - (v) from a point 25 metres west of its junction with Francis Avenue in a westerly direction for a distance of 112 metres
  - b)** Amend Item 8 (c) (iv) in Schedule 32 relating to a residents' parking place in Clarence Road to read:
    - (iv) from a point 27 metres south-east of its junction with Florence Road to a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Burgoyne Road
  - c)** Amend Item 1 (b) (ii) in Schedule 19 relating to a residents' parking place in Lucknow Street to read:
    - (ii) from a point 66 metres west of its junction with Fratton Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres
  - d)** Amend Item 14 (b) (ii) in Schedule 12 relating to a residents' parking place in Guildford Road to read:
    - (ii) from a point 5 metres north of its junction with Renny Road to a point 11 metres south of its junction with Lincoln Road


## STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE ORDER

- Portsmouth City Council aims to significantly increase the number of local journeys made by bicycle, as part of a wider ambition to make the city cleaner, safer and greener. The provision of secure cycle storage on residential streets has been identified as a key measure that will contribute to this aim. Improved local cycle storage will make it easier for those living in small, flat fronted houses or flats to own a bike, removing the need to carry it up and down stairs or store it in living space. Providing a safe space on street to store a bike will enable cycling to become a viable mode of transport for local journeys and some commutes that are currently undertaken in private cars;
- For any of the purposes specified in s.87(1)(a-c) of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality).
