

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (CONSOLIDATED) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (NO.2) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 9 March 2021 made the above Order under sections 32, 35, 36 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation on 16 March 2021. The effect is to revoke and consolidate into one Order the traffic regulation orders listed below relating to residential disabled bays. The parking restrictions remain unchanged on-street.
