

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (STATION ROAD, DRAYTON) (WAITING RESTRICTION AMENDMENT) (NO.4) ORDER 2020**

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (‘the 1984 Act’), as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (“the 2007 Regulations”), and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Station Road, Drayton) (Waiting Restriction Amendment) (No.4) Order 2020 and shall come into operation on 24 September 2020.
2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this order.
3. The Order specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is hereby varied as specified in that Schedule.
4. A failure by any person to comply with any requirement of this Order shall be a contravention of this Order and a Penalty Charge shall be payable by the Owner.
5. The requirements, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any requirement, prohibition or restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act, or by any other enactment.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ORDER**

1. The Portsmouth City Council (Consolidation) (On–Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting and Loading) (No.1) Order 2019

**(a)** Delete Item 1172 (b) in Schedule 1 relating to double yellow lines in Station Road, Drayton.

**(b)** Amend Item 1172 (d) in Schedule 1 relating to double yellow lines in Station Road, Drayton, to read:

The west side from a point 131 metres south of its junction with Grove Road in a southerly and westerly direction for a distance of 283 metres


**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE ORDER**

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of such danger arising;
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs;
- For any of the purposes specified in s.87(1)(a-c) of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality);
- To accommodate the new junction providing access to the new housing development on the former dairy site.
