

# THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (MAYFIELD SCHOOL) (AMENDMENTS TO WAITING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.49) ORDER 2021

4 June 2021: Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council ("the Council") proposes to make the above Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007, and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act. The effect would be as follows:

## A) AMENDMENTS TO SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR ZIG ZAGS FOR OLD/NEW ENTRANCES

### 1. Mayfield Road

Current position	Revised position
(i) North side, the 43.5-metre length opposite even Nos.108-116	North side, a 43.5m length from opposite No.120 eastwards to opposite the centre of Kenyon Road junction
(ii) North side, the 29-metre length opposite even Nos.136-144	North side, a 29m length from opposite No.156 to opposite the access road to the side of No.162

## B) PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME (double yellow lines)

### 1. Hewett Road

South side, a 25m length opposite odd Nos.107-115; for a new access

### 2. Kensington Road

West side, a 24m length opposite No.118, Domum Road junction and No.120; for a new access

### 3. Mayfield Road

(a) North side, a 16m length opposite even Nos.146-150; for a new access

(b) South side, a 6m length outside No.160, around the new kerb build-out to reduce crossing distance;

## CITY COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the amendments to the school keep clear restrictions required in conjunction with the closure of the former school and construction of new school and entrances (with Planning Permission).
