

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 102) ORDER 2021

16 September 2021: Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council ("the Council") proposes to make the above Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act), as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007, of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act. The effect would be as follows:

- A) NO WAITING AT ANY TIME** (double yellow lines; measurements exclude footway width)
- 1. Althorpe Drive**
North-east side, a 7m length in front of the access to Nos. 14-20, just south of Adstone Lane junction, and extending 7m north-west and 7m south-east of the entrance
 - 2. Bourne Road**
South side, extend the double yellow lines eastwards by 10m outside Units 9 & 10 Paulsgrove Enterprise Centre
 - 3. Colebrook Avenue**
Both sides, extend the double yellow lines eastwards by 4m
 - 4. Hunter Road (also see Part C below)**
South side, extend the double yellow lines eastwards by 3m alongside No.30 Winter Road
 - 5. Leominster Road**
South side, a 5m length westwards and 3m eastwards of Mortimer Road junction
 - 6. Lower Farlington Road**
West side, extend the double yellow lines northwards by 13m outside Nos. 48 and 50, to join up with the existing restriction opposite No.45
 - 7. Mortimer Road**
Both sides, a 5m length southwards from Leominster Road junction
 - 8. Station Road, Drayton**
South-west side, a 9m length on the corner junction by No.169
- B) EXTENSION TO RESIDENTS' PARKING BAY (GA ZONE)**
- 1. Clive Road**
North side, extend the parking bay 4m west outside No.1
- C) ADJUST DISABLED BAY POSITION**
- 1. Hunter Road**
South side adjacent No.30 Winter Road: move existing disabled bay eastwards by 3m away from the junction, and extend the double yellow lines to match the opposite side
- D) EXTENSION TO OPERATING TIMES OF SINGLE YELLOW LINE FROM:
MONDAY TO SATURDAY 8AM-6PM TO: 7 DAYS A WEEK 8AM - 6PM**
- 1. St Swithun's Road**
North side, the 21m length west of Copnor Road, adjacent to the Co-op store
- E) EXTENSION TO OPERATING TIMES OF LOADING ONLY BAY FROM 9AM-11AM TO:
9AM-1PM**
- 1. Chasewater Avenue**
East side, the 19m bay south of Tangier Road, adjacent to the Co-op store
- F) REDUCE OPERATING TIME OF 30-MIN LIMITED WAITING BAY FROM 11AM-6PM TO:
1PM-6PM**
- 1. Chasewater Avenue**
East side, the 19m bay south of Tangier Road, adjacent to the Co-op store

G) ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENTS

This order also updates existing traffic orders relating to parking restrictions to ensure consistency, making no changes on the public highway itself.
