

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 124) ORDER 2021

26 October 2021: Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007, and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, to install enforceable disabled bays for qualifying residents.

A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at these locations:
