

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (FAWCETT ROAD) (AMENDMENTS TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (NO. 147) ORDER 2021

The Portsmouth City Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 4 the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), as amended, section 23 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, and of all other enabling powers and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Fawcett Road) (Amendments to Waiting Restrictions) (No.147) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the 6 December 2021.
2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Section or Part or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Section or Part or Schedule bearing that number or letter in this Order unless otherwise stated.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. The Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby varied as specified in that Schedule.
5. The requirements, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any requirement, prohibition or restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1

AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING ORDERS

1. The Portsmouth City Council (Fawcett Road) (Amendments to Waiting Restrictions) (No.43) Experimental Order 2021
 - a) The order is hereby revoked.

2. The Portsmouth City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking and Restrictions on Waiting and Loading) (No.1) Order 2019
 - a) Amend Item 10 (a) (i) in Schedule 66 relating to a limited waiting bay in Fawcett Road to read:
 - (a) The east side;
 - (i) from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Manners Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres
 - (ii) from a point 27 metres south of its junction with Manners Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 14 metres


STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE ORDER

- The footway buildout aims to prioritise pedestrians by extending footway space, creating a "parklet" to encourage regeneration of the locality and improve the street scene;
- Contributes to making Portsmouth city cleaner, safer and greener;
- For any of the purposes specified in s.87(1)(a-c) of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality).
- This order makes the provisions implemented under ETRO 43/2021 permanent.
