

Notice of Suspension

The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Private Hire Vehicles in Bus Lanes Amendment) (No. 40) Experimental Order 2022

Portsmouth City Council, made an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order on 11th March 2022 which introduced the following changes listed below.

The Order came into operation on 25th March 2022.

The effect of the Order was to enable Private Hire Vehicles (PHVs) to use bus lanes and bus gates where taxis are currently permitted.

In pursuance of Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the provisions of the Experimental Order, the Director of Regeneration has **suspended the Order on 25th March 2022**, with immediate effect, in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic.
