- 8. The Solent Recreational Mitigation Contribution or the Nutrient Neutrality Mitigation Contribution cannot be transferred as mitigation for the development of another site.
- 9. No refund of this Solent Recreational Mitigation Contribution or the Nutrient Neutrality Mitigation Contribution will be made unless the application does not receive approval or is withdrawn.
- 10. In respect of any refund (including where an application is withdrawn) I further acknowledge that:
 - a) The total amount refunded will be the sum of original Solent Recreational Mitigation Contribution and the Nutrient Neutrality Mitigation Contribution paid, less an administration fee of £50
 - b) No interest will accrue to be refunded
 - c) No refund will be made until the period for appeal has passed or an appeal has been dismissed or six months has elapsed since the date of withdrawal
 - d) If an appeal against refusal is made and is allowed by the Planning Inspectorate no refund will be made.
