

## **The Portsmouth City Council (Guildhall Walk) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (No.99) Order 2022**

26<sup>th</sup> November 2022: Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order. The effect would be to introduce the following:

### **One Way except Cycles**

1. Guildhall Walk, from its junction with Alex Rose Lane to 33m southeast of Spring Gardens.

### **Pedestrian & Cycle Zone, except for access**

**No Waiting at Any and No Loading between 11am and 4am.**

**Pay and Display Parking and Taxi Rank will be removed**

2. Guildhall Walk, from its junction with Alex Rose Lane to 33m southeast of Spring Gardens.

### **Prohibition of Motor Vehicles, except for access**

3. King Henry I Street, from 5m southeast of its junction with Spring Gardens, south-eastwards for 28 metres

### **Disabled Parking Bays, Waiting Limited to 3 Hours, no return 1 hour In place of Pay and Display Parking**

4. King Henry I Street, From 5m southeast of its junction with Spring Gardens, south-eastwards for 18m

### **No Waiting at Any Time except Taxis, 8am - 5pm**

**In place of Pay and Display parking.**

5. King Henry I Street, northeast side, from its junction with Spring Gardens, north-westwards for 15m

### **No Loading at Any Time**

6. King Henry I Street, both sides, from 23m south its junction with Spring Gardens, southwards for 10m

### **No Waiting at Any Time**

7. King Henry I Street, north side, from 15m north of its junction with Spring Gardens, southwards to its junction with Guildhall Walk
