

HMO Additional Licencing Application Checklist

Documentation
A floor plan showing the room sizes in metric units. You'll need to label the usage of every room including bathrooms and ensuites and show the location of smoke/heat detectors and carbon monoxide alarms. Please note this does not have to be drawn by a professional
A fire risk assessment (FRA) – If you don't have a current FRA at the time of your application you will be issued with a 1-year licence and a special condition will be added to your licence requiring you to get a FRA for your HMO
Safety certificates – all current and satisfactory at the time of application
Gas safety certificate (if relevant)
A satisfactory Electrical Installation Report (EICR)
Fire Alarm Test Certificate (if relevant)
Emergency lighting (if installed) – annual check
A PAT certificate for any appliances supplied by the landlord. If the items are new, then a copy of the receipt will be sufficient
Optional items
The following are optional but are required to meet the criteria for a 5-year licence.
☐ EPC Certificate
Details of accreditation if you are an accredited landlord or agent this can be a copy of your certificate
or reference number. Details of approved accreditation schemes can be found on the Accreditation
scheme information page on our website ¹
