

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Waiting Restriction) (No.296) Order 2023

"no waiting at any time" (Double Yellow Lines) restrictions are proposed to prevent obstruction by parked cars adjacent to a proposed traffic island on Warren Avenue by its junction with Edenbridge Road. The traffic island is being funded by a nearby residential development under a S106 agreement, in order to improve access for pedestrians in the area of St James.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (i.e. to improve safety)
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) (i.e. to maintain access and/or to reduce congestion)

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
