

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (STAMSHAW NORTH) (PERMIT PARKING SCHEME) (NO. 116) ORDER 2023

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 51, 52 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Stamshaw North) (Permit Parking Scheme) (No. 116) Order 2023 and shall come into operation on the 11th December 2023.

GENERAL

2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to an Article or Section or Part or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Section or Part or Schedule bearing that number or letter in this Order.
3. The requirements, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any requirement, prohibition or restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act, or by any other enactment.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

INTERPRETATION

5. In this Order:
 - (I) "Principal Order" means The Portsmouth City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting and Loading) (No. 1) Order 2022 as amended.
 - (II) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (III) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.
 - (IV) the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:
 - "Business" means a business which is registered for the purpose of paying non-domestic rates and is at a postal address that is in any road or part of a road or zone specified in Schedules 3, 4 and 5;
 - "Council" means Portsmouth City Council;
 - "Civil Enforcement Officer" means any person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and control parking in the City of Portsmouth and to carry out such other functions as may be conferred by or under any enactment;
 - "Disabled person" and "disabled person's badge" have the same meanings as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Persons Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000;

"display" in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, means on the inside surface of the windscreen on the nearside so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"goods" means goods of any kind, whether aminate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"goods vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"motor cycle" and "invalid carriage" have the same meanings respectively as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"owner" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"parking contravention" has the meaning as assigned to it in Part 1 of Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"parking place" means any area on a highway designated as such by this Order;

"parking space" means a space in a parking place referred to in Schedule 3 which is provided for the leaving of vehicles;

"penalty charge" has the same meaning as in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

"penalty charge and reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid to the Council within 28 days beginning on the date of the Notice, or in 14 days in the case of a reduced penalty charge, following the issue of the penalty charge notice;

"Permit" means a document issued by the Council under the provisions of this Order which exempts a vehicle from certain parking restrictions. The different types of Permits are specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order;

"Permit holder" means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order;

"Permit Parking Zone" means the roads described in Schedule 1;

"Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;

"Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, intended or adapted for use on roads.

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

6. Each of the lengths of road identified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 3 having a width as indicated by the road markings, or in the case of signed only areas a width that extends from the centre of the carriageway to the back of the highway, are designated as a parking place.

7. The limits of each parking place and the limits of each parking space, if marked within a parking place, shall be indicate on the highway by traffic signs of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

MANNER OF STANDING IN A PARKING PLACE

8. A Vehicle left in a parking place must be parked wholly within the limits of the parking place.
9. Unless prior consent from the Council is obtained, no vehicle must be left in a parking place used in connection with the sale of any goods or services, except where goods are being delivered to any premises in the area.
10. No Vehicle left in a parking place shall be left in a position which prevents access to any premises or obstructs other road users.

VEHICLES FOR WHICH PARKING PLACES ARE DESIGNATED.

11. Each parking place referred to in Schedule 3 may be used subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are passenger vehicles, goods vehicles, motorcycles or invalid carriages.

SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES

12. The Council or any person so authorised by the Council may suspend use of a parking place or part of a parking place as considered necessary.
13. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a parking place which has been suspended.

PERMIT PARKING OR TIME-LIMITED PARKING PLACES

14. No Vehicle shall be left in a parking place to which a Permit parking with time-limited parking restriction applies, during the restricted hours specified in Column 4 of Schedule 3 to this Order, for longer than the maximum stay as specified in Column 5, Schedule 3 to this Order, unless a valid Permit has been issued in respect of that vehicle.
15. No Vehicle left in a parking place to which a Permit parking with a time-limited parking restriction applies, during the restricted hours shall return to any parking place in the same street within the no return period, as specified in Column 6, Schedule 3 to this Order, unless a valid Permit has been issued in respect of that vehicle.

APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUE OF PERMITS FOR THE USE OF PARKING PLACES

16. An application for a Permit must be made in a manner specified by the Council.
17. The Council may require an applicant to produce such evidence as considered necessary to verify any information submitted.
18. A Permit may only be issued by the Council to an applicant who meets the eligibility criteria specified in column 6 of Schedule 2.
19. The charge for issuing a Permit shall be as specified in Column 2, Column 3 and Column 4 of Schedule 2.
20. A duplicate of a Permit may be issued by the Council if the original Permit has been lost, stolen or becomes mutilated, defaced, faded, discoloured or otherwise illegible.

21. An amendment permit may be issued by the Council by virtue of the owner changing his vehicle.
22. An amendment or duplicate Permit will only be issued on surrender of the original Permit.
23. The charge for issuing a duplicate or amendment Permit shall be £10.
24. The Council reserves the right to vary the policy, charges and terms for the issue of a Permit as it considers appropriate and may provide written notice of any such variation as it considers appropriate.
25. Notwithstanding the preceding Articles, the issuing of Permits is at the absolute discretion of the Council.

VALIDITY OF PERMITS

26. A Permit shall not be valid when used in contravention of the conditions of use specified in column 7 of Schedule 2 , or in contravention of any other terms or conditions of use set out by the Council.
27. A Permit shall only be valid for use in the Permit Parking Zone.
28. A Permit shall permanently cease to be valid in the following circumstances:
 - a) After the expiry date specified on it.
 - b) The Permit holder ceases to be eligible.
 - c) The withdrawal of the Permit by the Council.
 - d) The issue of a duplicate or amendment Permit by the Council.
 - e) The Council believes the Permit is being used in a dishonest or fraudulent manner, or intentionally used in contravention of the conditions of use set out by the Council.

WITHDRAWAL AND SURRENDER OF PERMITS

29. A Permit holder may surrender the Permit to the Council at any time.
30. A Permit holder must surrender a Permit to the Council in the circumstances specified in Article 25.
31. The Council may serve notice to withdraw a Permit; on receipt of this notice the Permit holder shall surrender the Permit within 48 hours.
32. The notice specified in Article 28 shall be served to the Permit holder at the address or email address given on their application or at any other address believed to be the Permit holder's residence or place of business.

MISHANDLING OF PARKING DOCUMENTS

33. The Parking Team Manager or any employee of the Council working on his behalf, and all Civil Enforcement Officers are authorised to act in accordance with Section 116 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

EXEMPTIONS

34. Nothing in this Order shall apply to:
 - (a) Anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer;

- (b) A vehicle being used for fire and rescue (within the meaning of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004), ambulance (including providing a response to an emergency at the request of an NHS ambulance service), bomb or explosive disposal, special forces, police or National Crime Agency purposes and the observance of a provision of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used;
- (c) A vehicle being used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus, for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus and the observance of a provision of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used;
- (d) A vehicle being used by or on behalf of the Council or water authority in pursuance of a statutory power or duty and the observance of a provision of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used;
- (e) A vehicle being used by or on behalf of a Statutory Undertaker in pursuance of a statutory power or duty and the observance of a provision of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used;
- (f) In connection with a wedding or funeral provided that the vehicle can be reasonable use for that purpose on the road;
- (g) To allow the opening or closing of a gate or barrier at an entrance to which the vehicle requires access, or has just exited from; or
- (h) A Disabled Persons Vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge.

CONTRAVENTION

35. If a vehicle is left in a parking place at any time during the permitted hours without complying with the provisions of this Order, then a contravention shall be deemed to have occurred, and a penalty charge shall be payable.

REMOVAL OF VEHICLES

36. Where a vehicle is left in a parking place without complying with the provisions of this Order, the vehicle may be removed or caused to be removed from that parking place as provided by the Regulations made under section 99 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
37. Any person removing or arranging a vehicle to be removed under Article 31 must make such arrangements as reasonably necessary for the safe custody of that vehicle.

AMENDMENTS

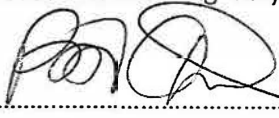
38. The contents of Schedule 4 shall be added to Schedule 1 to the Principal Order.

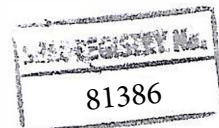

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order introduces a Permit parking scheme which applies at all times in roads in the Stamshaw North area of Portsmouth. The Order also updates descriptions of waiting restrictions to align with what is marked on the road.
