

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (FAWCETT ROAD) (LOADING BAY) ORDER 2024

As part of the School Streets project and introducing timed restrictions to Heyward Road term time only, during school drop off and pick up times, Portsmouth City Council is proposing to advertise a permanent traffic regulation order (TRO) to introduce loading bay in front of Lalys Pharmacy, 151 Fawcett Road to enable safe loading and unloading space. Loading bay times of operation will be Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm, consistent with current parking restrictions.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); or

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
