

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (CANAL WALK & SOMERS ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2024**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council the Portsmouth City Council made the above Order on 14 February 2024. The effect of the Order will be to introduce a prohibition of motor vehicles in the following roads:
 - a) **Canal Walk**, between a point 8 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Bridgeside Close and its junction with Somers Road; and
 - b) **Somers Road**, between its junction with Canal Walk and a point 48 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Raglan Street.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
4. This Order comes into operation on 19 February 2024
