

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND CYCLE PARKING) ORDER 2024**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order would be:
 - a) To introduce "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions in the following roads, to enable a bike hangar 3 metres long to be installed: **Kimberley Road** *east side* outside no 41 (in place of parking for MG zone permit holders), **Drayton Road** *east side* from 9 metres south of its junction with Laburnum Grove southwards for 3 metres, **Silchester Road** *east side* from 8 metres north of its junction with Tangier Road northwards for 3 metres, **Kimberley Road**, *east side* from the property boundary of Nos 39 and 41 southwards for 3 metres, **Kimbolton Road** *east side* from 3 metres south of its junction with Hayling Avenue southwards for 5 metres, **Margate Road** *south side* from 8 metres west of its junction with St Andrews Road westwards for 3 metres (in place of parking for 3 hours/LB permit holders), **Exmouth Road** *west side* outside Southsea MOT centre (in place of parking for MD permit holders), **Allens Road** *south side* from 9 metres east of its junction with Waverley Road eastwards for 3 metres (in place of parking for MD permit holders), **Malvern Road** *west side* from 10 metres south of its junction with Clarendon Road southwards for 3 metres (in place of parking for 3 hours/KC permit holders), **Adair Road** *east side* from 4 metres north of its junction with Tokar Street northwards for 3 metres (in place of in place of parking for MG permit holders), **Fordingbridge Road** *east side* from 11 metres north of its junction with Henderson Road northwards for 3 metres (in place of parking for MH permit holders)

It is proposed to install bike hangars at the following locations, making no changes to existing parking and waiting restrictions: **Copnor Road** *west side* at its junction with Queens Road (on the footway outside Mary Road Manor), **Seagers Court** *north side* outside The Old Pilots Office, **Elm Grove** *north side* approximately 10 metres east of its junction with Green Road (at the back of the footway), **Nightingale Road** *east side* at its junction with Kent Road (on the footway outside Stephen Lodge), **South Parade** *north side* outside Netley Mansions (on the kerb buildout at its junction with Eastern Villas Road), **Devonshire Avenue** *south side* outside No 192 (on the kerb buildout), **Knox Road** *east side* at its junction with Meyrick Road (on land adjacent to No 35 Meyrick Road),
4. Persons wishing to object to or make other representations with regard to these proposals must do so in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made. Representations must be sent to TROteam@portsmouthcc.gov.uk or by post to TRO team, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Portsmouth PO1 2NE, quoting ref TRO P008-24 within 21 days of the date of this Notice (18 April 2024) stating the grounds for the objection.
