

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (TRO P034 - 24) (Part 1) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 12 June 2024 made the above Order. The Order comes into operation on 14 June 2024, to effect:

A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at these locations:
