

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (KING HENRY 1 STREET) (PARKING PLACE) (NO.22)
ORDER 2024**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council made the above Order on 17 May 2024.
2. The effect of the Order will be to:

Replace a Taxi Rank (8am - 5pm, every day) with Pay and Display parking 8am - 6pm every day on King Henry I Street north side from the extended south-eastern kerbline of Spring Gardens, north-westwards for 15 metres.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
5. This Order comes into operation on 23 May 2024.
