

**PROPOSED SPEED HUMPS, MILTON
ESSEX ROAD, MIDDLESEX ROAD AND SUFFOLK ROAD**

1. Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to introduce road humps under the Highways Act 1980.
2. The purpose of the road humps is to form a continuous level route across side roads to make it easier for people with additional mobility needs (e.g. users of mobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs) to access local facilities.
3. The road humps would be in the form of flat top raised tables across the full width of the carriageway as follows:

Location	Height	Length (plateau)	Ramp length and gradient
Essex Road - junction with A288 (Eastney Road)	75mm	2500mm	800mm, 1:10
Middlesex Road - junction with A288 (Eastney Road)	75mm	2500mm	800mm, 1:10
Suffolk Road - junction with A288 (Eastney Road)	75mm	2500mm	800mm, 1:10
