

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (LABURNUM GROVE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS)

Following requests from Imperial Homes Southern Counties Ltd., acting as an external housing developer for the development of Construction of a new housing development to include associated parking & refuse/cycle stores accessed via Laburnum Grove, at the location of the old Odeon Cinema, the proposal seeks to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) at the proposed entrance for waste collection access at the development.

Therefore, Portsmouth City Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) that establishes "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions on both, the north and the south side of the road in a length of 12.5 metres on each side.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

The reason for making this order is as follows:

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- c. to assist with the free flow of traffic,

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
