

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (TURNER ROAD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024

To ensure that the crossing point outside of Ark Dickens Primary School on Turner road is kept clear of traffic and available to use at all times of day Portsmouth City Council is proposing that the existing "No Waiting Monday - Friday 8am - 5pm" restriction is replaced by a "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction and the existing "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction on the north side opposite Buckland Children Centre is extended to the layby .

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- a)** for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; or
- b)** for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); or
- c)** for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
